

PORTABLE SIGNS

10. THE BACKGROUND FOR CONSTRUCTION WARNING SIGNS SHALL BE FLUORESCENT ORANGE COLOR ACCORDING TO SUPPLEMENTAL SPECIFICATION 638-2.02.

MOUNT SIGNS THAT ARE WIDER THAN 0.90 M OR LARGER THAN 1

THE CONTRACTOR MAY SUBMIT. FOR APPROVAL BY THE ENGINEER. ALTERNATE TEMPORARY SIGN MOUNTING WHICH FULLY COMPLIES

FOR POSTS GREATER THAN 0.10 X 0.10 SEE THE BREAKAWAY

PORTABLE SIGNS MAY BE MOUNTED LOWER THAN FIXED SIGNS

MOUNTING FOR PORTABLE SIGNS SHALL HOLD THE SIGN FACE IN A

FOR SIGNS REQUIRING POSTS 0.15 X 0.15 AND GREATER, SIGNS ARE

METERS APART. DO NOT PLACE HOLES IN POST OF NON-BREAKAWAY

SIGN MOUNTED ON PORTABLE SUPPORTS SHALL NOT BE USED FOR-

CONSIDERED TO BE NON-BREAKAWAY IF MULTIPLE POSTS ARE REQUIRED AND THE POSTS CANNOT BE SPACED A MINIMUM OF 2.1

SQUARE METER ON TWO POSTS. SEE TABLE.
