


DETAIL 3—BED PLANTING



DETAIL 4-SLOPE PLANTING

NOTES:

- WHEN A PORTION OF A PLANT BED EXTENTS INTO AN AREA STEEPER THAN 4:1, SCARIFYING OF THAT PORTION WILL BE OMITTED AND THE ENTIRE AREA BETWEEN PLANTS SHALL BE MULCHED TO BLEND IN WITH THE SCARIFIED BED.
- 2. IN AREAS WHERE SCARIFICATION IS OMITTED, EXISTING GRASS AND WEED GROWTH SHALL BE REDUCED TO A MAXIMUM 50 MM (2") IN HEIGHT BY MOWING.
- 3. WHEN BARE ROUTS PLANTS ARE USED IN BEDS, SHRUB ILLUSTRATION AND ROOT PLACEMENT SHALL CONFORM TO DETAIL 2

GENERAL NOTES:

- 1— THE DIAMETER OF ALL PLANT PITS SHALL BE AT LEAST 2 OR 3
 TIMES GREATER THAN THE BALL DIAMETER. FOR BARE ROOT PLANTS,
 SEE STANDARD SPECIFICATION 626—3.05. LOCATE THE ROOT BALL ON SOLID SOIL AND NOT LOOSE BACKFILL
- 2- THE PIT DEPTHS SHALL COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENT. OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATION 626-PLANTING.
- 3-MULCH SHALL BE APPLIED AROUND ALL PLANT TO A MINIMUN DEPTH OF 100 MM (4") OVER ENTIRE PLANT PIT. AGED SHREDDED HARDWOOD BARK, LICORICE ROOT OR AGED WOOD CHIPS CAN BE USED. ANY MULCH CONTAINING PRESERVATIVES IS UNACCEPTABLE.
- 4-BACKFILL WITH NATIVE SOIL UNLESS CONSIDERED UNSUITABLE. IN THAT CASE FILL PIT WITH GOOD QUALITY TOPSOIL
- 5- THE ENTIRE AREA OF THE PLANTING PITS SHALL BE GRADED SO THAT THE MAXIMUM SLOPE DOES NOT EXCEED 10:1 IN ANY
- 6- TREES SHALL NOT BE PLANTED WITHIN THE CLEAR ZONE.
- 7- BACKFILL TOP SOIL MULCH, FILTER FABRIC AND PITS WILL BE CONSIDERED A SUBSIDIARY OBLIGATION.
- 8- THE CONTRACT UNIT PRICE FOR EACH OF THE PARTICULAR PAY ITEMS COVERED UNDER THE STANDARD SPECIFICATION 826-PLANTING WILL CONSTITUTE FULL COMPENSATION FOR INCIDENTALS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THIS WORK.
- 9- ALL DIMENSIONS SHOWN ARE IN MILIMETERS UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.

NOTES:

- 1. WHEN BARE ROOT PLANTS ARE USED ON SLOPES, SHRUB ILLUSTRATION AND ROOT PLACEMENT SHALL CONFORM TO DETAIL 2.
- 2. ON SLOPES STEEPER THAN 3:1, THE FRONT CENTER OF THE PIT SHALL BE MODIFIED TO INCLUDE A "V" CUT THE FULL DEPTH OF THE PIT. THE PIT SHALL BE DUG 2" DEEPER AND BACKFILLED WITH 2" OF MATERIAL A-2-4, DAYLIGHTED TO THE SLOPE FACE, AND COVERED WITH FILTER FABRIC PRIOR TO BACK FILLING WITH SOIL MIXTURE.
