The project consists of improvements to the intersection of highway PR-2 with PR-114 at the Sábalos Ward in Mayagüez (intersection where the Centro de Servicios al Conductor, CESCO, is located). The purpose of the virtual presentation is to inform the public and agencies concerning the proposed project and maintenance of traffic during the construction.
