## public notice

The Highways and Transportation Authority (ACT) informs the general public that it proposes to adopt the Fourth Amendment to Regulation 01-003, "RULES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF RATES, USE AND ENJOYMENT OF THE URBAN TRAIN TRANSPORTATION SERVICE", with the purpose to establish the necessary standards and criteria to achieve the greatest acceptance and optimal functioning of the Urban Train. These criteria include those essential to maintain order and promote a pleasant environment that ensures a pleasant trip for system users. Making it more inclusive and open to the use of bicycles and micro mobility.

In addition, Article IX, entitled Animals, Luggage, Bicycles or Other Articles, is amended in its subsection D regarding the transportation of bicycles on the Urban Train. This Regulation is adopted pursuant to the provisions of Law Number 74 of June 23, 1965, as amended, known as the "Puerto Rico Highways and Transportation Authority Law" and Law No. 38-2017, as amended, known as the "Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto

The PRHTA will provide a period of thirty (30) days, starting from the date of publication of this Notice to receive written comments from the public or to request in writing an oral hearing on the proposed action with the grounds that, in the opinion of the applicant make necessary the granting of said hearing to present their comments verbally. Said comments shall be delivered to the Organization and Methods Office, Monday through Friday from 8:00am to 4:00pm, except holidays. Your comments are very important, therefore, they will be thoroughly evaluated and, if considered appropriate, they will be included in the final document.
