Public Notice

The Department of Transportation and Public Works and the Puerto Rico Highway and Transportation Authority hereby notify the public, private providers of transportation services and federal, state and municipal governments the opportunity to review and provide comments on the following:

- 2026 Safety Performance Targets for the Puerto Rico Strategic Highway Safety Plan
- Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the fiscal years 2023-2026, Amendment 4
The TIP includes the programs and projects to improve the transit and highway system to be financed with funds from Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) in the urban areas.
- Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for fiscal years 2023-2026, Amendment 4
This document includes the programs and projects to improve the Islandwide transit and highway system to be financed with funds from FTA and FHWA. STIP must be approved by Federal Agencies.

The Puerto Rico Metropolitan Planning Organization is considering, by referendum, the 2026 Safety Performance Targets for the Puerto Rico Strategic Highway Safety Plan and the amendments to the FHWA component of the TIPs, for Urbanized Area of San Juan, Aguadilla and Under 200,000 Population.
